These are my directions following a case conference conducted on September 19, 2024.

First, I confirm that the AGBC has withdrawn as an intervener, and that the record filed by the AGBC will no longer form part of the record for the consideration of the panel on the reference. The materials will however remain in the public court file, subject to any motion any remaining intervener may choose to bring for a confidentiality order. Any such motion must be brought promptly and in any event on or before October 7, 2024.

Second, I confirm the undertaking of counsel for the Canadian Lottery Coalition Members that he will advise the court promptly if he receives instructions from any of his Coalition clients to

withdraw as an intervener, or if the scope of the Coalition Members' opposition to the AGO will be narrower than as communicated at the case conference.

Third, the schedule for delivery of factums and page limits will be as follows.

October 11, 2024: AGO's factum (40 pages)

October 25, 2024: Canadian Lottery Coalition Members' factum (40 pages)

November 5, 2024: Remaining interveners' factums (15 pages each)

November 15, 2024: Reply factums of the AGO and the Canadian Lottery Coalition Members (20 pages each)

Fourth, the time allocation for oral argument will be as follows, in this order:

AGO: 4 hours (including time for reply)

CGA, NSUS, and Flutter: 30 minutes each, in an order of their choosing

Canadian Lottery Coalition Members: 4 hours

Mohawk Council of Kahnawà:ke: 30 minutes

AGO: reply
